Health

All the sale cattle have been vaccinated with Ultrvac 7 in 1, pestigard and 3 germ blood.

The OSullivan's herd is accredited free of TB and Brucellosis. We are in a protected zone for bovine JD.

All sale cattle will be treated with Cydectin prior to sale and will be clear of cattle tick enabling them to be presented clean at inspection yards.

All sale cattle are eligible to travel to all states and territories with the exception of WA.

Delivery

Delivery is available after the sale by arrangement with vendor or agents. Free agistment, at the purchasers risk, is available until October 1st 2017.

Transport

There will be livestock carriers in attendance. We are able to assist in the arrangement of transport throughout Australia.

Insurance

Insurance can be effected at the conclusion of sale, we strongly recommend at least 6 months insurance.

Catering

Food and refreshments will be available at the sale venue.

Accommodation

There is ample accommodation available at either, Gatton, Ipswich or Willowbank. Both Toowoomba and Brisbane are within a 1-hour drive.

Flights

You will be met on arrival of your flight, provided you contact the agents with your arrival times at least 3 days prior. Commercial flights operate daily to both Brisbane and Toowoomba airports.

Due care has been taken in compiling this catalogue, however responsibility lies with prospective purchasers to determine its accuracy.

MANAGING YOUR NEW BULL

The bull you have just purchased is ready for work.

He has been measured, tested and closely examined to ensure, to the best of our ability, that he will produce plenty of top calves for you in coming years. Whether this happens or not is largely dependent on how you manage and use him.

1. Comprehensively insure your bull for the next six to twelve months. He will be most susceptible to injury and loss during his first joining.
2. Don't let him run with older bulls until after his first mating.
3. Keep him in condition score 3 (forward store) all year, this will ensure that he can produce plenty of fertile semen and allow him to achieve his full mature weight.
4. Do not mate him with older bulls, they will dominate and reduce his proportion of pregnancies. If the older bull is not fully fertile then pregnancy rates can suffer dramatically.
5. Check your new bull twice a week during his first mating. Young bulls are more prone to damaging their penis and sheath than older sires. If you notice swelling along the sheath get him checked immediately.
6. Keep him healthy. An annual 5-1 booster vaccination and strategic drenching should be standard practice. Check for lice as they can render a bull temporarily infertile if his scrotum and sheath become heavily infested.
7. Bulls can develop problems as they age. Wear and tear on joints and ligaments, small injuries and other factors can reduce their mating potential over time. Put your bulls through a breeding soundness examination well before each joining season to detect problems before they affect herd fertility and cost you money.

THE HELMSMAN SELLING SYSTEM

Auctions don't have to be stressful environments. The Helmsman system combines the best features of an auction system and sale by private treaty.

You have more time to consider lodging your bid. You can place genuine bids on any bull of your choice at any time during the sale period.

You have the opportunity to reassess each lot during the sale period without any pressure to make an instant decision. You take home the bulls that you want, irrespective of the lot order.

If you are considering buying a number of bulls you will have a better chance to average your purchase costs in order to meet your budget.

People say that the "Helmsman" system is buyer friendly because it helps them get better value for money. The simultaneous auction method enables them to switch to the best valued animal at any time during the sale.

HOW THE HELMSMAN SYSTEM WORKS

1. On arrival intending purchasers need to register at the bid table and receive a buyer number.
2. All animals are displayed for inspection prior to, and during the sale.
3. When the sale commences, all animals are on the market simultaneously. You may bid on any animal regardless of lot number, by filling in a bid card and handing it to the receptionist at the bid table, agent, or to a 'runner'.
4. You may open bidding at the reserve price indicated for each animal in the catalogue and contest bids in multiples of no less than \$250.00.
5. Bids are recorded, with the buyer's number, on a large board adjacent to the animals. You can bid on any number of animals at once, and see at a glance whether your bid still stands or has been over-bid.
6. There is no pressure to commit yourself to another bid. If your 'first choice' animal goes beyond your limit you can still bid on any other animal in the sale.

1. The highest bidder shall, subject to Condition 2, be the Purchaser provided that the Vendor reserves the right to bid either by himself or through his Agent or Auctioneer and should any dispute arise among the bidders for any lot, during or immediately after the sale of the lot, it shall be settled at the Auctioneers absolute discretion who may, should one of the disputants advance, put the lot or lots up again.  2. (2) FEMALES - Save and except for female calves at foot, all females are guaranteed to be in calf or go into calf by the later of:

- (a) 6 months of the date of sale
- (b) the animal reaching the age of 30 months

A positive pregnancy test certified by a qualified veterinary surgeon shall be sufficient evidence that the animal is in calf.

(3) Claims under Clauses 17(1) and 17(2). A claim that an animal has failed to satisfy a guarantee of fertility under Clause 17(1) or 17(2) must be made to the Vendor within the relevant guarantee period but prior to the animal entering a quarantine area other than on the Vendor's property.

(a) All claims must be accompanied by a certificate from a registered veterinarian surgeon in accordance with the guidelines established by the Australian Association of Cattle Veterinarians which must clearly identify the basis of the claim.

(b) Subject to Clause 17(9), infertility resulting from injury or disease occurring after the sale of the animal is not covered by this guarantee.

If the animal proves fertile within the period such status must be confirmed by a certificate issued by a registered veterinary surgeon in accordance with the guideline established by the Australian Association of Cattle Veterinarians and costs incurred must be borne by the Purchaser. If the animal is not proven fertile within the period, the costs incurred must be borne by the Vendor.

(4) LIABILITY OF A VENDOR - Except for costs defined elsewhere in the conditions of sale, the liability of a Vendor in respect of claims relating to fertility shall not exceed the purchase price of the animal(s) or provide mutually agreed upon replacement animal(s).

(5) In the event of a claim being substantiated:

(a) The purchase price shall be refunded within 14 days unless a mutually agreed upon replacement animal has been provided.

(b) The animal/s which are the subject of the claim shall automatically become the property of the Vendor and be returned to him or disposed of according to his instruction at his expense.

(6) Subject to Clause 17(9), this guarantee is of no effect if:

(a) The animal is returned to the Vendor.

(i) In poor physical condition or with any injury;

(ii) Tests carried out on behalf of the Vendor within fourteen days of such return proved positive to any diseases which may affect the animal's fertility or ability to breed naturally; or

(b) The Purchaser has collected and stored semen from a bull or

(c) The Purchaser attempted any form of embryo collection from a female.

(7) In the event of a dispute as to whether a lot is a breeder, such dispute shall be resolved by the Vendor and the Purchaser. The Auctioneer, while he will use his best endeavours to assist, shall have no liability or responsibility in that regard. If an animal is alleged or proved not to be a breeder, the Purchaser must nevertheless pay the Auctioneer the full purchase price and any other monies or interest payable by the Purchaser in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

(8) EVIDENCE OF FERTILITY — A Certificate issued by a registered veterinary surgeon at or before the time of sale than an animal is fertile (unless it is a certificate stating in respect of a female that she is in calf at the time of sale) does not, of itself, satisfy or discharge the Vendor's obligations under the guarantee of fertility given under this Clause 17. All animals, except calves at foot, must prove their fertility within the relevant guarantee period.

(9) RELIEF FROM GUARANTEE — If the Vendor seeks to be relieved from the obligations which would otherwise be imposed upon him by this clause by virtue of Clauses 17(3)(b) or 17(6)(a), the onus of proof is upon the Vendor to establish that:

(a) The animal suffered the injury or disease or is in poor physical condition due to circumstances and events occurring after the sale, and

(b) The injury, disease of physical condition is the sole cause of the animal's infertility or failure to prove fertility within the guarantee period.

(10) DEFINITION — For the purpose of this Clause 17, the expression "guarantee period" means:

(a) in relation to bulls — the period specified in Clause 17(1) as being the period in which the bull must prove his fertility; and

(b) in relation to females — the period specified in Clause 17(2) as being the period in which the female must go into calf.

18. (a) Each lot shall be at the risk of the Vendor in respect of any damage or injury, whether by disease, accident or otherwise, or whether caused by the negligence of the Auctioneer for the period that the lot be in the custody of the Auctioneer, unless such lots shall have been sold in which latter case such lot shall be at the risk of the Purchaser in all such respects.

(b) If any Vendor brings to the sale premises any lot which is dangerous, or infected with any disease, that Vendor shall be liable for all injury, damages, costs, losses or expenses which the Auctioneer may sustain, incur or be put to either directly or indirectly as a result of the Vendor so doing. The Auctioneer reserves the right, at its absolute discretion, to exclude from the sale, or put out of the sale venue or dispose of, any lot which in its opinion shows signs of any disease, whether infectious, contagious or not, or of any serious fault or of being dangerous.

19. DELIVERY — Except at the discretion of the Auctioneer no lot shall be delivered to the Purchaser unless payment of the purchase money together with any additional charges incurred including those expenses incurred by the Auctioneer pursuant to Condition 14 hereof, is first made by the Purchaser to the Auctioneer. Release of lots may be withheld by the Auctioneer until personal cheques are received.

20. In these Conditions:—

(a) References to "Auctioneer" shall be taken to mean as the context so admits, the Selling Agent or any member, subsidiary or related corporation or body, officer, agent or employee thereof, authorised by the Vendor to conduct the sale of the lot;

(b) "Purchaser" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in Condition 1;

(c) "Vendor" shall mean the person or corporation upon whose account lots are offered for sale and where a stud or farm is named shall mean the proprietor of that stud or farm;

(d) "Lot" shall be taken to mean the animal offered for sale and/or sold by the Auctioneer on behalf of a Vendor.

UNDERSTANDING EBVS

An Estimated Breeding Value (EBV) is an estimate of the genetic merit of that animal for each trait measured. EBVs are provided for the following traits:

Calving Ease (DIR) EBVs are estimates of genetic differences in the ability of a sire's calves to be born unassisted from two year old heifers. The EBVs are reported as differences in the percentage of unassisted calvings.

Gestation Length EBV : this EBV ranks sires for the time between conception and the birth of a calf. Shorter gestation is indicated by negative EBVs and longer by positive EBVs.

Birth Weight EBV : this EBV indicates the genetic potential for birth weight. Positive EBVs indicate higher birth weights and negative EBVs indicate lower birth weights of progeny.

Milk EBV : an important component of fast growth to weaning is the dam's maternal performance. A bull with a high milk EBV should produce daughters which milk well.

200, 400 & 600 Day Weight EBVs : these EBVs give us an estimation of the animal's genetic potential for growth to the various ages.

Scrotal Size EBV : the scrotal size EBV indicates whether the bull will produce sons with above average or below average scrotal sizes.

Carcase Weight EBVs are estimates of the genetic differences between animals in hot standard carcass weight at 650 days of age.

Eye Muscle Area EBVs are estimates of the genetic differences between animals in eye muscle area at 12/13th rib site in a standard weight steer carcass. EMA EBVs are expressed in square centimetres (cm²).

Rib Fat EBVs are estimates of the genetic differences between animals in fat depth at the 12/13th rib site in a standard weight steer carcass. Rib Fat EBVs are expressed in millimetres (mm).

Rump Fat EBVs are estimates of the genetic differences between animals in fat depth at the P8 rump site in a standard weight steer carcass. Rump Fat EBVs are expressed in millimetres (mm).

Retail Beef Yield (RBY) EBVs are estimates of genetic differences between animals in boned out retail beef yield in a standard weight steer carcass. RBY EBVs are reported as differences in percentage (%) yield.

Intramuscular Fat (IMF) EBVs are estimates of genetic differences between animals in intramuscular fat (marbling) at the 12/13 rib site in a standard weight steer carcass. IMF EBVs are reported as differences in percentage (%) IMF.

Docility EBV : the docility EBV is expressed as the increase or decrease in the percentage of progeny that will be scored as docile (score 1 or 2). Positive EBVs indicate a higher proportion of progeny that will be scored as docile and negative EBVs indicate a lower percentage of progeny being scored as docile.

The EBVs for Limousins cannot be compared with EBVs for animals of other breeds. They should be compared with the current average EBV for the Limousin breed shown below.

The EBVs for Lim-flex animals are also set to the Limousin base so can be compared directly with EBVs for Limousin animals.

Accuracies

Accuracies are presented with each EBV and give an indication of the amount of information that has been used in the calculation of that EBV. The higher the accuracy the lower the likelihood of change in the animal's EBV as more information is analysed for that animal and its relatives.

LIMOUSIN ASSURANCE PROGRAM

OSullivans Limousins are members of the Limousin Program (LAP).



As part of the program we sell only registered Limousin cattle which have been docility scored. We also provide warranties for fertility and docility as follows:

Fertility Warranty

Females

Females over 12 months and sold as unjoined are warranted fertile to natural service within 12 months. The purchaser is to have the right to a full refund of the purchase price of the female (excluding any costs and expenses of the purchaser) on submitting a veterinary report after the expiration of 12 months to the effect that the purchaser has been unable to get the female in calf to natural service. The veterinarian must state that in his opinion there is no evidence that the female has suffered any injury or illness since being sold to the purchaser which could have affected her breeding ability. The veterinarian must also state that in his opinion there is no evidence that the female has been subjected to embryo transfer procedures. The veterinary report (together with a statutory declaration by the purchaser to the effect that the substance of the report is true and correct) must be forwarded to the vendor (with a copy to ALBS) within 14 days of the first anniversary of the sale date.

Bulls

All bulls sold as fertile and capable of natural service. The purchaser is to have the right to a full refund of the purchase price of the bull (excluding any costs and expenses of the purchaser) within six months of the date of the sale subject to submitting a veterinarian's report stating that the bull is infertile or incapable of natural service. The veterinarian must also state that in his opinion the bull has not suffered any injury or illness since being sold to the purchaser which could have affected his breeding ability. The veterinary report (together with a statutory declaration by the purchaser to the effect that the substance of the report is believed by the purchaser to be true and correct) must be forwarded to the vendor (with a copy to ALBS) within 14 days of the date being six months after the sale date.

Docility Warranty

All animals are sold as having acceptable docility as defined as score 1, 2 and better than a score of 3 in the official scoring system of the Australian Limousin Breeders' Society. The purchaser is to have the right to a full refund of the purchase price of the animal (excluding any costs and expenses of the purchaser) within 28 days of the date of the sale or a replacement animal of similar quality and price to be supplied by the vendor subject to submitting a veterinarian's report stating that the animal is of unacceptable docility defined as score 4 or 5 in the official scoring system of the Australian Limousin Breeders' Society.

The veterinarian must state that in his opinion the animal has not been mistreated in a way which would have affected its behaviour since being sold to the purchaser. The veterinary report (together with a statutory declaration by the purchaser to the effect that the substance of the report is believed to be true and correct) must be forwarded to the vendor within 14 days of the date being 14 days after the sale date.

THE POLL GENE & THE BLACK GENE IN CATTLE

Most characteristics of cattle like growth, milk and fertility are controlled by multiple genes. A few traits such as pollness and colour are controlled by a single set of genes. Therefore the outcome of a particular joining, in regards to these traits can be accurately predicted.

THE POLL GENE

- An animal that is naturally without horns is called a **Poll**.
- The poll gene is dominant and the horn gene is recessive.
- A poll animal can carry a pair of poll genes this is called homozygous poll.
- A poll animal can carry a poll gene and a horn gene this is called heterozygous poll. Some Heterozygous animals have scurs.
- A horned (or dehorned) animal carries a pair of recessive horn genes.
- A homozygous poll animal will always pass a poll gene onto its progeny; therefore **all progeny of a homo poll animal will be poll**, even if the other parent is horned.
- A heterozygous poll animal will pass either a poll gene or a horn gene to its progeny with a 50/50 chance of either. It follows that on average **any poll** animal will **produce a least 50% poll** progeny from horned parents and at least 75% poll progeny from polled parents.
- A horned animal will always pass a horn gene to its progeny.
- There is a DNA test available to test for homozygous poll. This is 98% accurate not 100%, so there is the slight chance of a tested homo poll not being homo poll.

THE SCUR GENE

- Scurs are a horn like growth that is attached to the skin rather than the skull. Scurs are normally quite short and bunt, and can often take 12 months or longer to become evident.
- The scur gene is a dominant gene in males but a recessive gene in females; this is why it is much more likely to see a scur on a bull than a scur on a female.

THE COLOUR GENE

- There are a number of colour patterns in cattle.
- Some of these are quite complicated; for example Charolais, Simmental, Murray Greys and others can have a diluting gene, and we see white face and socks on Hereford cattle and brindle cattle are not uncommon.
- The solid colours of black and red (or apricot as it is often referred to in Limousin) are quite simple, in that they are controlled by a single set of genes. Similar to the way the poll/horn gene functions.

THE BLACK GENE

- In a similar way as the Poll gene the Black gene is dominant and the Red gene is recessive.
- A black animal can carry a pair of black genes this is called homozygous black.
- A black animal can carry a black gene and a red gene this is called heterozygous black.
- A red animal always carries a pair of red genes.
- In the case of solid colours the following applies;
 - A homozygous black animal will always pass a black gene onto its progeny; therefore **all progeny of a homo black animal will be black**, even if the other parent is red.
 - A heterozygous black animal will pass either a black gene or a red gene to its progeny with a 50/50 chance of either. It follows that on average **any black** animal will **produce a least 50% black** progeny from red parents and at least 75% black progeny from black parents.
 - A red animal always carries a pair of red genes and will always pass a red gene to its progeny.
- The above can be affected by other complicated colour patterns, eg white patches (face, legs and body), diluting of black to grey, etc.
- A DNA test is available for testing for the black gene this test is accurate.
